All-Gender Restroom

All-gender restrooms are single-occupancy spaces available to all members of the UNE community and guests, including transgender and gender non-conforming people.

All-gender restrooms provide access to safe bathrooms and changing areas for people of any gender identity and presentation. They also provide safe spaces for those who need the assistance of a personal care attendant or those with small children. For privacy, please lock the door behind you when inside.

In this restroom, we ask that no one will be stared at, questioned, or asked to leave. Multi-occupancy, gendered restrooms are located nearby for persons who wish to use these facilities.

Case Western

- free menstrual products in women's and all gender bathrooms in academic buildings, as well as, in the student center, library, Women's Center and LGBT Center
- New menstrual product & sexual health task force: resolution included the placement of menstrual products in women's, men's, and all gender bathrooms on campus. We're hoping to get them in men's bathrooms next year by the efforts of a new all gender bathroom task force.

Bowdoin College

- We have them in many women's and all gender bathrooms that are in central locations, and they are in men's rooms in at least the student union, and maybe the dining halls, I am not 100%. Our student government leaders made the decision to provide them, and that included putting them in the men's room. All is part of a program they call "Free Flow", and there is a sign in the men's room explaining that some people who use the men's room menstruate and therefore need pads and/or tampons too.

University of Nebraska at Omaha

- free menstrual products in all gender bathrooms and women's bathrooms in the student center. We also have free products in one multiple stall bathroom in each building. We are currently working on building a map.

Kent State University

- We are working with our Women's and Gender Center to do the same by offering menstruation products in the women's room and the universal restrooms that are located in the student center building.
